Biggest Challenges?

Timeliness

- Timelines of publishing/access to phase 3 clinical trial results
- Time to review data by NACI and the regulatory authorities (who will authorize vaccine after assessment)
 - NACI may need to review 7-10 vaccines and compare the vaccine's effective population against the populations in Canada

Safety review systems will need to be prepped in advance, both passive and active systems

• PT-level and Federal-level collaboration required

Messaging via professional organizations will also be important

- Translation of the science for the groups they interact with
- Need to support the evidence and not raise concerns where there aren't any concerns

CPhA

Asked about shipping/transport/stability in regards to ultra-frozen requirements

- Noted that mRNA vaccines -60 to -80 for transport, thaw 24h at room temperature
 - another year for a stable mRNA vaccine
