The provided email **is** Health Canada's process of fast tracking the licensing of products as it is. We are trying to keep the political out of this process, and let the experts at Health decide what licensing requests are or are not legitimate. All applications are being looked at in a timely manner and responded to as such. As I am sure you can imagine, that isn't necessarily a same-day response, but they are reviewing every single submission.
