For your planning purposes, I can tell you we now have 3,210 ventilators delivered. However, we aren't going to be able to give you a breakdown of each contract and, in terms of quantities ordered, ISED and Health are better positioned to answer that. PSPC doesn't make these kinds of determinations – we act on the advice of PHAC and, when it comes to domestic manufacturing, ISED as well.
