

- The Task Force from the outset established a formal process for members to declare interests and to recuse themselves from deliberations where there is a Conflict of Interest, as is mentioned on the Task Force website.
- These declarations have all been monitored and formally document by the Task Force Secretariat, as have been the Conflict of Interest and Confidentiality Agreements submitted at commencement of the Task Force by each Task Force member.
- As a volunteer external advisory body, members of the COVID-19 Vaccine Task Force do not submit their Conflict of Interest declarations to the public registry. The records of the Task Force including its recommendations to the Government are logged into the official files of the Department of Innovation, Science and Economic Development.
- The Task Force does not make funding decisions. The Task Force only provides advice to Ministers who make the decisions, which are supported by further due diligence conducted by their departments.
