RE: Request for Support on Initiating a PPE Supply Chain Solution between Canada and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam

Dear Prime Minister Trudeau.

On behalf of the Canada-ASEAN Business Council ("CABC"), our members and our collective extended stakeholder networks, we are writing to you to ask that the Government of Canada make a formal request to the Government of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam to assist the CABC's efforts in making available / developing a procurement program for PPE goods for Canada's domestic battle against the COVID-19 virus.

Vietnam is a trading partner of growing importance to Canada, and is well-positioned to help us diversify from an existing narrow band of PPE suppliers. Vietnam, as you may know, has seen exceptional success in its efforts to contain its domestic spread of the COVID-19 virus; it is thus now re-positioning its strong manufacturing capabilities to be able to export its PPE goods to its trading partners to support their efforts.

The CABC, with the specific support of the National Bank of Canada, has laid the groundwork to open up this channel for Canada. We have identified a particularly urgent need for additional PPE in Québec's health system, where we intend to open a direct supply link between Vietnamese producers and Québec's healthcare institutions. Once opened, we believe this supply chain can then quickly expand to the rest of Canada and the other provincial healthcare systems.

While Canada's efforts to secure significant supply lines from China are commendable, we believe that by building on these efforts and diversifying into Vietnam we can both increase the quantity of available PPE goods and decrease the risk of over-reliance on a single market.

Close collaboration with Vietnam on COVID-19 will further help to deepen our relationship with a key trade partner in the CPTPP, in what is also a priority region for Canada's overall trade diversification (ASEAN). CABC is a strong advocate for Canada's trade engagement with ASEAN and we are proud to have supported the conclusion of exploratory discussions on a potential free-trade agreement with ASEAN. By reaching out to Vietnam in this way, we can work together to continue to support these important objectives.



While this is a private sector-led initiative, we look forward to working closely with Global Affairs Canada and your office to realise this important and urgent opportunity. We stand ready to assist with next steps, and look forward to hearing from you.
