I'm only interested in finding out when the 40,000 ventilators the prime minister said in May were being delivered are actually going to be delivered.

The U.S. promised 100,000 by mid-July and in fact delivered on that and are now looking at getting another 100,000 before the end of the year.

I don't believe the PM promised an end date for the deliveries in Canada but as of today, only 407/40,000 are in hand. When are the other supposed to arrive? Where are they going?

Are they going to the provinces to distribute?

Staying in federal hands until the province asks?

What is our updated estimate on how many ventilators Canada actually needs?

How many ventilators total do the provinces and Ottawa have towards that need?

Those are the questions I'm looking to have answered ASAP.
