**CONTEXT** (for your information):

**QUESTION AND ANSWER:**

**Q1. The Prime Minister of Canada said this week that Canada will be getting millions more items of personal protective equipment. Does your department have a list of where all this will be coming from?**

Our number one priority, right now, is getting the supplies needed, as quickly as possible, to protect public health.
