Hi Gowthaman,

I just got off the phone with Mark Entwistle, formerly Canada's Ambassador to Cuba and now a managing partner with Acasta Capital in Toronto.

He is eager to discuss a UK company called Medical Device Training International (MDTI). They are in the process of having a novel ventilator design fast-tracked through the regulatory process in the UK for possible mass manufacturing to deal with the pandemic.

He believes it could have similar applicability here in Canada.

I am not familiar with how proposals of this nature are being processed at the moment. Do you have any advice?

He also wished me to relay a [Canada-UK MOU signed in 2017](#) that could be activated in these circumstances to facilitate the technology exchange.
