Context

NRC is working to publish the registry and once we have confirmation that it is live, we will add the following lines to the KMs and re-send:

- The Vaccine Task Force is committed to transparency and has a robust conflict of interest process in place.
- The process is consistent with the practices of other volunteer external advisory bodies to government and embodies international best practices.
- Given the significant interest in the Vaccine Task Force's process, the Task Force is taking the exceptional step of publishing a registry of declared interests.
- The registry will be updated on the NRC's website following each vaccine announcement by the government that is based on a Task Force recommendation.

You may also have noted that Dr Kobinger raised the issue of CanSino funding in the iPolitics article. We noted that NRC used the following line recently to respond to a *Global News* request that included a question on the funding:

1. Government funding

The Government of Canada is not providing funding to CanSino.

We are checking with the NRC to see if there is more that can be said. **If Minister Anand receives a question on CanSino at the presser, her office should refer the question to the NRC**, since the NRC is the one to have announced the collaborative partnership, and the NRC has consistently been the lead spokes on this topic throughout.
