> On April 2, Quebec identified urgent need for reagents for testing purposes.

>

> As a short-term mitigation measure, NML sent reagents for 2,500 extractions to Quebec on April 2. On April 3, NML sent reagents for additional 5,000 extractions. At present, Quebec is continuing with extractions for COVID-19. Based on discussions with Quebec, they are currently focusing their use of extraction reagents on health-care workers, hospitalized patients, and pooled samples. QC is using a crude extraction method for samples that are not in under their current focus (this is not ideal, but it still allows them to process specimens). NML also sent out the "home brew" recipe o QC in the interim in case they have the capacity to make the reagents as a stop gap.

> To support provinces and territories, NML sent a federal call out regarding KingFisher Extraction Machines on April 4. From this call out, NML will be sending 5-6 KingFisher Extraction Machines to Quebec. The machines are currently in transit to NML to validate that the machines are in proper operating condition before the machines are redistributed to Quebec. This effort is being prioritized to ensure that Quebec receives the machines to continue testing. > The NML has secured an in-Canada production supply of extraction reagents. Should there be no further supply chain or shipping challenges, the first batch of extraction reagents (50,000) is expected to be shipped at the end of this week (April 9<x-apple-data-detectors://4>). When this batch of reagents is available, reagents for 45,000 extractions will be sent to Quebec on a priority basis.
