Hi there,

South Korea is donating 35,000 masks to Canadian Veterans of the Korean War to show their appreciation of the 25,000 Canadians who served there. They are giving masks to Veterans in 22 countries.

VAC is now the lead for GoC on this - had been GAC.

The masks arrived in Canada on the 15th and the South Korean Embassy got them today

The Embassy looking at holding a small event on Thursday at the Embassy w/ ambassador, VAC's DM and representative from the Korean Veterans Association . I should have a scenario later today.

We are looking at setting up a Zoom call for Min MacAulay with the Ambassador to thank him.

Attached is a draft NR, but I'm told PCO has said we should be social media only, because everything around masks has been low-key. I'm okay with it either way.

VAC has a list of long-term care facilities across the country where there are Korean War Vets (there aren't many). The Korean Veteran Association will also help the embassy by using their membership lists
