Hi All,

I was advised today by Sienna Seniors Living, the largest LTC and seniors home provider in Ontario and the third largest in Canada, that they will soon be making a request to the federal government to bring in the army because they are so short staffed.

Sienna is part of the Canadian Association to Protect and Equip Seniors (CAPES), a coalition of long term care and seniors home providers. Leslie and I have had a few calls with CAPES and Leslie's team and our Ambassador are working hard to help them get some of their PPE out of China.

Sienna indicated they have been advised by the Ontario government last Tuesday that measures were put in place to ensure hospitals send some of their staff to LTC homes but this is not happening.

They are grateful for the help we have provided to date on the ground in China.
