## HC APPROVALS: May 26

#### MEDICAL DEVICES

As of <u>May 26</u>, Health Canada has authorized a **total** of **200** medical devices under the *Interim order*.

- 19 test kits
- 180 non-diagnostic devices (non-IVDD devices):
  - o 8 N95 masks
  - 43 surgical masks
  - o 58 face shields
  - o 6 ventilators
  - o 11 gloves
  - o 5 sterilizers
  - 49 Others (thermometers, airway management, beds, swabs, isolation kits, ventilator accessories, AI for diagnosis, test reagents, monitors, software, sterilizer solution, glucose monitoring, Spirometer, Bipap, CPAP helmets, infusion pumps and a thermal camera).

## HAND SANITIZERS & DISINFECTANTS

As of May 26, Health Canada has authorized:

- 99 disinfectants
- 2,519 new hand sanitizer products
- 1,606 new site licences for over-the-counter drugs and natural health products.

# INTERIM ORDER ON DRUG AND MEDICAL DEVICE SHORTAGES (imports):

- As of <u>May 26</u>, Health Canada has added 77 total medical devices to the *List of* Medical Devices for Exceptional Import and Sale under the Interim Order.<sup>1</sup>
  - Ventilator: 1
  - o Masks: 49
  - N95 respirator: 4
  - o Gowns (including apron, sleeve): 12
  - Protective suit/coverall: 4
  - Respirator filter: 1
  - Face shield: 2
  - o Gloves: 4
- As of <u>May 26</u>, Health Canada has added a **total** of **39 drugs** to the *List of Drugs for Exceptional Import and Sale* under the Interim Order.<sup>2</sup>

# MEDICAL DEVICE ESTABLISHMENT LICENCES (MDELs)

- As of May 26, total MDELs issued under the interim order: 1,399
- Total MDEL applications remaining in the queue: 30

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Companies with a drug establishment license may import drugs on the *List of Drugs for Exceptional Import and Sale* after notifying Health Canada 5 days in advance of importation.
