Ben, Marci, Chris, Cameron, Jer,

For this proposed attached NR for tomorrow it is a \$4B announcement for PPE procurement that is effectively mostly for PTs.

I guess I would suggest, does it make sense to put this into the PPE/health streams for SRA negotiations? Or at a minimum, hold it a few more days and then put it into that context so we get some more credit for it at the negotiating table as another downpayment?

See below as to the breakdown of what it pays for (largely PT):

- \$2.48 billion for the procurement of additional personal protective equipment and supply purchases for provinces and territories (PT) and health care workers (e.g., N95 masks, testing kits and ventilators).
- \$885 million for Canadian companies to produce up to 40,000 ventilators to ensure domestic supply of this equipment. Contracts are being finalized with four domestic

suppliers. Each company would agree to produce 10,000 ventilators at a cost of approximately \$25,000 per unit.

- o \$210 million for the purchase of 40,000 IV pumps.
- \$95 million for the purchase of 82 sterilization machines (with an option to purchase an additional 100 machines) required to supplement PT capacity to sterilize and reuse N95 respirators, in light of the unprecedented demand for PPE, including masks.
- o \$378 million for others items, including the following:
- \$168 million for transport and logistic costs, including aircraft charters, associated with goods being shipped from Shanghai, China. Three contracts are currently in place at a cost of \$60 million, with costs anticipated to increase.
- \$179 million for the National Microbiology Laboratory for the procurement of reagents (substance used to for laboratory testing), point of care testing, and development of diagnostic reagents for COVID-19 to support PTs and remote communities.
