Quick Facts - PPE & equipment

- Flights: Over 25 flights from China have arrived in Canada with supplies, with several more on the way;
- Hand sanitizer: Canada's domestic capacity to produce hand sanitizer has more than quadrupled since February;
 - Enough sanitizer to fill eight Olympic-sized swimming pools every month;
- PPE Tariffs: Last week, we waived tariffs on certain medical goods for importers, including PPE such as masks and gloves
 - This will reduce the cost of imported PPE for Cdn businesses, which can face tariffs of up to 18%

- Medical Gowns: 22 Letters of Intent & 18 contracts in place with domestic suppliers for 32M gowns,
 including: Canada Goose, Calko Group & Stanfield's
- Reagent: Luminultra in N-B is keeping P/Ts supplied with enough reagent on a weekly basis through to March 2021 so they can increase their testing capacity;
- Ventilators: Have sent 400+ ventilators to P/Ts & have received new ventilator shipments from domestic & international suppliers over these last few weeks, including from Thornhill Medical in Toronto;
- Medicom: Long-term agreement with Medicom, of Pointe-Claire, Quebec, to manufacture 20 million
 N95 respirators and 24 million of surgical masks per year for the next 10 years starting this summer;
- N95s: Thousands of N95s from 3M left for Canada yesterday, with over 300k more expected over the next few weeks;
- Supply Council: Minister Anand announced a COVID-19 Supply Council which brings together a diverse group of leaders to provide advice on building innovative and agile PPE supply chains from start to finish;
