Ms. Hajdu,

I hope you are well. I live on the Island of Montreal in the riding of Notre-Dame-de-Grâce. The Honourable Marc Garneau, the elected MP of this riding, asked me to contact you directly (see attached email).

We would like to be part of the Government of Canada's efforts to restock its inventory of personal protective equipment to fight COVID-19. We are proposing to manufacture gowns and surgical masks that are made according to the standards required by Quebec. You will find the description of manufacturing standards for each item (appendices 1 and 2) attached to this email. The production capability is in the millions for each item, and the factories are located in Vietnam. We have extensive knowledge of supply chains for importing clothing into Canada from Vietnam because we have been working in retail for 15 years. Deliveries are usually by sea, but we are currently exploring shipping by air.

We hope to build a strong partnership to fully support the collective effort of caring for our citizens while supplying suitable equipment to protect health care workers. **If there are needs to be met, we would be pleased to have a discussion with you to offer our services and clarify the quantities, deadlines and prices.**
