Caitlin here is a quick status update.

Michael (the amazing officer on the file) confirmed he called and emailed Sadiq twice as recently as noon today to get a quote a price in cdn dollars. Sadiq has not done so since he was initially asked on March 20.

His last price is about 40% more than what we have paid for any other masks. We would be ok with that if he delivered 1m in Canada ASAP. For context not a single supplier to date has been able to do that, once the contract is signed they back off their delivery date.

Since you brought the matter to my attention we have redouble efforts to get him to provide the needed pricing info.

Hi Arianne – Sadiq Valliani, via his company (2247533 Alberta Ltd.), has secured an order of 1M N95 masks, with the potential for 5M more in two weeks. The masks are produced at Shanghai Dasheng Health Products Manufacture in China, which supplies Home Depot with their N95s.

Yesterday AM, he received a note from Phillippe Bisson, from PSPC confirming the he masks he has are up to spec and that HC has issued a Medical Device Establishment License – so all is good to go. But hasn't heard back since. Sadiq is hoping to get the first 1M N95 masks on a plane tomorrow, any update we could provide him on the status of the contract would be much appreciated.
