- On June 6, Health Canada issued a recall for certain hand sanitizers that contain industrial-grade ethanol
- Industrial-grade ethanol can be harmful if not used properly, and is not approved for use in hand sanitizers.
- My department has listed the recalled products on our website. Should you have any of the listed products, stop using them
- If you have used these products and have concerns about your health, please contact your healthcare professional.

If pressed:

- Health Canada has directed companies to stop selling these products. They are monitoring impacted companies' recalls.
- If the department identifies additional products or manufacturers using ethanol that does not meet requirements, they will take appropriate action.
- Our website with information on recalls is updated regularly, as the department becomes aware of affected products. We encourage Canadians to check it if they have concerns.

I'm adding our issues advisor Ash here who may be able to help. Not sure if we presently have lines on TGE.

If we did, they would likely say something along the lines of: "Recognizing the significant supply constraints for hand sanitizer made with traditional ethanol inputs, Health Canada has temporarily authorized the use of technical grade ethanol in hand sanitizers as an interim measure. The measure is time-limited and we are actively working to reduce the level of impurities in the product of TGE suppliers."
