CONTEXT (for your information): The reporter is seeking information about the scheduled delivery dates for surgical masks and N95 respirators from Medicom. He says that Mitch Davies (Senior Assistant Deputy Minister for Innovation, Science and

Economic Development Canada) testified in the House of Commons' government operations committee today where he conveyed that PSPC has all this information.

QUESTION AND ANSWER:

Q1. Under PSPC's personal protective equipment contract with Medicom, what are the scheduled delivery dates for surgical masks and N95 respirators?

A1. Medicom is working to meet the commitments it has made to the Government of Canada for supply. We anticipate expect domestically produced surgical mask deliveries to start ramping up late in July and the first deliveries of N95 respirators in by the end of August, from Medicom.though delivery dates could be subject to changes.
