Dear Ms. Hajdu,

I hope you are well. I am a citizen from the Island of Montréal, in the Notre-Dame-de-Grâce riding. Its elected Member of Parliament, the Honourable Marc Garneau, asked me to contact you directly (see attached email).

We would like to contribute to the Government of Canada's efforts to replenish its inventory of COVID-19 personal protective equipment. We propose manufacturing protective gowns and surgical masks made entirely according to the standards required by the Government of Quebec. A description of the manufacturing standards required for each items is attached to this email (Appendices A and B). Production capacity is measured in millions for each product and the plants are located in Vietnam. We have a sound knowledge of the logistical chains used to import clothing to Canada from Vietnam, since we have been in the retail business for 15 years. Shipments are usually made by boat and we are currently looking at using planes.

We would like to build a strong partnership to support the collective effort to care for our citizens and ensuring that the adequate equipment is available to protect health care workers. **If there are any requirements, we would be happy to participate in a discussion with you to offer or services, and clarify quantities, deadlines and prices.**
