As mentioned on the Tuesday COM call, please see below a draft response for fact checking this morning to the Globe's question below on how many N95 and equivalent masks have passed testing.

Question: Can you tell me how many of the N95s that are listed as received have passed the testing requirements?

Draft Response:

All of the 61.7 million N95 and equivalent respirator masks have gone through initial quality assurances prior to the federal government accepting large deliveries of the product. Some have gone through further testing and have been inventoried, while others are going through this process.

This number does not include any masks that have failed to meet quality testing and product standards.
