**VALUE STATEMENT:** The Government of Canada is working with the provinces and territories on an ongoing basis to determine their needs and to purchase the equipment, supplies and services needed to respond to COVID-19.

Public Services and Procurement Canada is taking an aggressive approach to procurement, particularly with respect to personal protective equipment for front-line health care workers. Our approach is to:
