Hi Minister,

Here is today's update from our daily call with Canada Post. The items of note from today's call are:

### General Operations:

- There are 8 confirmed cases of COVID-19 amongst CPC employees (5 in St. John's, 1 in BC, 1 in Calgary, 1 in Antigonish, NS.)
- CPC continues to receive new shipments of disposable gloves and hand-sanitizer. These materials are being distributed to employees in corporate and dealer outlets across the country.

### St. John's:

- The processing plant is back open with reduced staff.
- 20 delivery agents were available today – 12 were dispatched to St. John's and Mount Pearl with a specific focus on delivering provincial and federal socio-economic checks. Delivery in the rest of the province went largely as scheduled.
- **93% of delivery agents at the St. John's facility are either in self-quarantine or on leave. Of the plant's 286 employees, there are 77 are off on leave, 111 in self-quarantine, 2 whose status remains uncertain, with about 95 employees available to work.**

### North Bay, ON

- The CPC facility in North Bay is back up and running. No impact to operations.
- 2 employees are in self-isolation – 1 has tested positive for COVID-19.

### Antigonish, NS:

- The CPC facility in Antigonish is back up and running. No impact to operations.
- 2 employees are in self-isolation – 1 has tested positive for COVID-19.
