Update- Ontario has provided a list of their needs. I'm dealing with this entire issue of premier ford giving my boss their needs before health gets a heads up or without his office even knowing. In the meantime, sharing with the hopes it can be shared with officials:

- 1) 500 k units of swabs and reagent -- As they are stepping up testing.
- 2) Nitrile gloves -- "As many as you have!" 10 m would be good.

- 3) Gowns -- Enough to keep us going. 250 k would be good.
- 4) N-95 masks and surgical masks. A lot! Currently, the weekly burn rate in Ontario is 500k N-95 masks a week, and 10 m surgical masks a week. (Please note -- roughly twice as high as the previous weekly burn rate.)
