These things are pretty safe:

- 6.36 million priMED surgical masks will be shipped to provinces and territories over the next couple of days.
- 745k KN95s have passed testing and should be shipped to P/Ts this week (I will need to triple confirm if Matt thinks it is wise to include this one though).

I believe Bauer face shields have come off the line & will soon be shipped so we can include this one (and some other face shields examples if you think that is right Matt).

Also, perhaps for another day - Matt what do you think about these?

- ISED intends to issue letters of intent (LOI) to three manufacturers of test kits, including LuminULTRA, brought forward under their Innovative Solutions Challenge. Two LOIs have been issued for laboratory diagnostic kits, which should begin shipping by mid-June, and a third LOI has been issued for a serological test. Discussions are ongoing with a potential manufacturer of a fourth test kit to determine whether the company would have the capacity to scale up production in the current context.
- PSPC advised that the ten-year contract with Medicom to establish domestic capacity for N95 respirator and surgical masks is ready for signing. Delivery is expected to begin in July, pending Medicom's ability to secure the required equipment from overseas. A new contract has been signed for the domestic production of 11.7 million gowns, with delivery starting May 8.
