Confirming two flights are coming in tonight with lots of supplies & that we're good to use the Toronto Stamp one.

Unfortunately PSPC department tweeted the Toronto Stamp delivery earlier this afternoon but it has like 30 likes & no one seems to have noticed it. I asked Min Anand's team if she could hold off on re-tweeting it until after the PM's remarks tmrw (in case you decide to keep it in tmrw).

I also added a small Hamilton Ontario story in case you're interested. Min Anand mentioned it in a Hamilton Spec interview but I don't see the article anywhere.

## Some more details:

- Confirmed: Two flights coming in tonight one at 9pm & one at 930 (Hamilton and Pearson)
  - Between the two of them there are 2.7 million KN95s & 65k protective coveralls (would not specify the #s though, given they have to be tested & we've been having some challenges)
  - There is also supplies on these flights for other jurisdictions (QC & ON)
- Two flights are also scheduled to come in over the weekend with more supplies
- New: Signed a contract with a supplier who will be manufacturing, out of Hamilton Ontario, 100k litres of hand sanitizer
  - The supplier isn't a Cdn company but it's great that folks in Hamilton are working on it I
- Confirmed: Through our call-out to suppliers on Buyandsell, we have signed a contract with Toronto Stamp, which is retooling its production to provide millions of face shields for healthcare workers.

Will need to triple check this with officials at our 6:30pm 4C and get back after that:

- Two flights should have arrived in Canada today
  - One of them has up to 2 million N95 masks & approx 35k of protective coveralls
  - o The other one has an unconfirmed number of N95s
  - o I will confirm with officials at 630pm that they've landed & how much was procured via us (vs provinces)
  - o Safe to say something like this: "Two planes full of N95 masks and coveralls arrived in Canada yesterday"
- There are also apparently two flights leaving on the 19<sup>th</sup> and two on the 21<sup>st</sup> with more supplies
