Harj's team tells me that this popped up as an idea late last week. SACEUR will provide an update on the COVID impact on NATO operations and mid to long-term planning. Ministers will likely raise a bit of everything: supply chains, pandemic preparedness, deployments, and regional security threats. The background context is growing NATO concern about Russian and Chinese attempts to take advantage of the crisis.

It will be the standard virtual format with short statements from each Minister. Harj's remarks include a section on preventing restrictions in supply chains and ensuring cooperation within NATO on critical needs. They are not expecting a specific agreement on national self-sufficiency (which is a tenet of NATO membership) or a deep rethinking of global supply chains, but more of a discussion of mutual support and collective action.

I'll make sure we get a proper readout, although it will likely come NATO classified.
