Hi team – please see below for a summary of tonight's procurement 4C.

Bumping positive developments to the top for comms:

- Donation from Red Cross & Chinese gov being sorted through
 - o Includes things like 100k test kits, 50k face masks, 100k surgical masks, isolation gowns, goggles, coveralls etc.
- Flight hopefully departing tomorrow to pick up 2 million N95s from China
- We are working with a number of jurisdictions to help them bring back their own supplies (ordered independently of us)
 - o For ex: QC has a cargo plane load worth of material that we're working to help bring over
- Luminaltra in NB now has enough components for reagent to be able to supply the country's testing needs for roughly seven weeks
 - o Luminaltra NB will ship out 45k tests worth of reagent to help out QC tomorrow (will arrive EOD)
 - 45k tests worth of reagent = good for QC for one week

Summary - April 8

PSPC Update:

- Main focus is finalizing contracts on domestic production & capacity at this stage
- The Medicom agreement has been signed & the contract will follow
- We continue to place orders for N95s, but global supply ordering of PPEs is slowing down
- As of this morning, there were 2 milion N95s in the warehouse of our broker at the Shanghai airport

Logistics

- We delayed the 2 million N95 China flight pick-up (will now hopefully be tmrw)
 - Ran into an issue last night with Chinese authorities the airline wanted to treat this as a delay of 24 hours, meanwhile they wanted to treat this as a new application for site clearance
 - Embassy worked hard on a diplomatic note to accelerate the process
 - Plane will leave tomorrow instead of having left today & will be back Sat with what should be around
 2 million N95 masks in it
 - The 2 million masks will arrive in Hamilton
- We are also picking up more flights
 - o In discussions with Air Canada today for three 777s leaving Sunday in order to catch up with increasing tempo of deliveries from the warehouse in China
 - We're getting a lot of requests for delivery assistance from provinces (for their own independent orders)
 we're trying to help as best we can in some cases, we may need to refer provinces to airlines &
 brokers

O QC has a cargo plane load worth of material so we're going to top up our flights with these materials in the coming days

Global supplies:

- More factories for PPEs in China are popping up abroad but quality is not top-notch
- There are also several new export rules in China that are dependent on the quality of what you are buying
 - o For ex: medical-grade products are tightly controlled; challenging getting N95 masks out
 - o Certain companies are permitted to export medical-grade products however

Reagents / Testing:

- Luminaltra in NB is producing reagent they have all of the components required to do this
- Luminaltra (NB) will ship 45, 000 tests worth of reagent to QC (who has put in an urgent request) tomorrow QC will receive by EOD tmrw
- 45, 000 tests = 7 days worth of testing
- Guanidinium is a chemical that is required for reagent & 1 tonne has been supplied to Luminaltra in NB
 - o 1 tonne amount means NB will be able to produce enough reagent to supply the country's current testing needs for seven weeks
- We're also looking to secure an additional 3 tonnes of Guanidinium from China
 - o If we receive this shipment (expected date is April 17th) then we will be in a position where we can supply 26 weeks worth of reagent across the country
- We're also working with Chem Tech who will be the domestic supplier of Guanidinium and we're expecting 5 tonnes from Bio Basics by the end of April
- In short we're doing well at securing the chemical component that is required for reagent and currently, we're in solid shape to meet the current needs of P/Ts over the coming weeks and months (and once we get our new shipments in, we'll have enough reagent supply for one full year)
 - o At the same time, we need to recognize that provinces are not at their full testing capacity right now
 - For ex While Ontario's reagent problem has been resolved for the time being, Premier Ford said today that he's extremely disappointed in the province's low testing numbers
- Still some factors that will influence us in the short term mainly the supply of Guanidinium from China
- P/T pressure w PEI:
 - o Some frustration in the media today
 - PEI said they were frustrated about turnaround time from NML to get test results
 - O DM discussion with the Deputy in PEI today to clarify that the turnaround time was not a laboratory testing issue it was a shipping issue from the province of PEI to our lab
 - We're also in the process of providing to PEI a testing platform so they can do their own testing within their province

P/T Pressure w ON:

Ontario notified us today that Sudbury has a reagent shortage; we're going to send over some supply ASAP

Shipments to provinces:

- The 7.8 milion surgical masks from the April 6 flight are already starting to arrive at the destination
- DND is helping us deliver the 225 ventilators from NESS that will start being shipped tmrw
- In addition 280+ expired N95s that were donated will be ready for delivery COB tomorrow
- Apple sent us three types of masks
 - o 2 / 3 types will be shipped immediately; the third one will need to be tested
- Cdn Red Cross is working through the donation we received from the Gov of China and C-Trip
 - o Red Cross will be allocating this on our behalf
- DPMO: Ontario is worried about the quality of the N95 masks that they're receiving (via their own independent shipments) – will there be enough N95s for them carved out from the 500k 3M N95 shipment that arrived last night?

- o We have asked AB if they can allocate their N92s from the 500k pile to ON
- **PMO:** With planes coming in over Easter weekend can we pls expedite testing?
 - o Don't think any of us will have a long weekend
- DPMO: Even though it is a long weekend will P/Ts still get shipments? Hope is that they will
 - We will make sure if shipments arrive, we let the P/Ts know and they're ready to receive; even if it is on a weekend
