- The new Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy was also introduced. This subsidy will be offered directly to commercial tenants.
- For the Canadian Emergency Business Account, loans have been expanded to \$60,000 for small businesses in need.
- We also launched the Regional Relief and Recovery Fund, which provides more than
   \$280 million to support Quebec businesses.
- For businesses that must temporarily close their doors in response to local public health directives,
   financial assistance will be provided directly to those affected.
