Looks good. This is the latest I got from health earlier today - so you may wish to say 2, 756 now! And perhaps include the last line too re allocation. Thoughts?

Federally, we started the pandemic with 539 ventilators in the NESS and deployed 439 of them to PTs. We have received an additional 2,756 ventilators of the ventilators procured due to COVID response of which 1,286 have completed QA verification and are considered accepted but are not yet deployed to PTs. We are expecting significant and increasing deliveries in the coming weeks and are in ongoing discussions with PTs on allocation strategies.

All five of the Canadian ventilator manufacturers with which the federal government holds agreements have now received Health Canada authorization, which the acceptance of deliveries is contingent upon. We have received more than 2,000 ventilators to date, with more arriving to the Public Health Agency of Canada every week, including regular deliveries from Canadian manufacturers.

Canada has met the demand for ventilators to date, and will continue to support the provinces and territories with the medical supplies that they need to protect the health and safety of Canadians. We continue to prepare for any eventuality as we have from the outset of this pandemic, and as deliveries continue to arrive.
