Domestic Capacity

We are ensuring that Canada has diversified sources of supply and pursuing every possible avenue to secure life-saving PPE and essential supplies to protect the health and safety of Canadians.

Canadian businesses of all sizes - right across the country - have truly stepped up to help protect Canadians.

Over the past 6 months, Canada has built industrial capacity that did not previously exist.

We now hold 55 contracts with Canadian manufacturers - reflecting 40 percent of contracts overall in terms of dollar amount.

Our focus continues to be on domestic retooling and production to build Canada's resilience.

We are establishing made-in-Canada solutions for this highly sought after product including 3M in Brockville for 25 million masks a year, and Medicom in Montreal for 20 million masks a year.

To date, we have received more than 61 million N95 or equivalent masks, including regular deliveries of 3M masks.

(Results):

- Canadian businesses of all sizes right across the country have truly stepped up to help protect Canadians.
- This has resulted in:
- o 15 contracts with Canadian textile manufacturers for the production of over 32 million medical grade gowns;
- o Deliveries are arriving from Stanfield's in Truro, NS, Canada Goose, Roudel Medical in Scarborough, and George Courey in Laval.
- o Westport Manufacturing is producing 500 thousand cloth masks
- o 18 contracts with Canadian manufacturers have been put in place for the purchase of 43,553,000 units of face shields
- We have also signed a contract for millions of gowns from Samuelsohn, in Montreal.

- o We have a long term agreement with Medicom, based in, Quebec, for the production of 20 million N95 respirator masks and 24 million surgical masks per year, for the next 10 years, expected to begin this summer.
- o Awarded a contract to GM Canada for 10 million surgical masks and face coverings to be produced in Oshawa, Ontario over the coming year.
- o We also have an agreement in place with LuminUltra, company based in New Brunswick to produce enough reagent for 500,000 more tests per week to help meet Canada's needs right through to March 2021.
- o Fluid Energy: Has delivered 10 million liters of hand sanitizer, nearly half of all of Canada's total order.
