Hi there,

As a heads up, Minister Anand did an interview with Mia Rabson on the work over the past few months on PPE procurement and the ongoing/forward plan on the procurement of PPE and related supplies in response to COVID-19 in preparing for future needs. This includes an "announcement" of the second contract with Becton Dickinson for an additional 37M syringes as well as the new 1 year contract with Precision ADM for 120,000 domestically produced 3D printed swabs a week.

This is expected to go live at 7 am tomorrow morning.

I did flag that this opportunity was coming up earlier in the week via email, but wanted to ensure this was confirmed in terms of when it will be out.
