Key Messages

- From the beginning we have been working with partners at all levels of government, and with industry, to secure life-saving medical supplies as part of a whole-of-government response to the COVID-19 outbreak.
- As part of our efforts, we have announced the COVID-19 Supply Council which will bring together a diverse group of leaders to provide advice on establishing further diversified and adaptable supply chains for key items so that we are prepared for any eventuality.
- This council builds on our collaborative approach to help us address current and future supply challenges, and ensure **that** Canadians have access to the supplies they need to stay safe and healthy

- Council members were selected based on their expertise and leadership in their respective fields to represent a range of sectors, backgrounds and regions across Canada.
- This is one venue for the work that our government and PSPC is doing to engage Canadian industry and sector leaders and it is certainly not the only example of this.
- The Supply Council is not meant to exclusively represent every interested sector in the COVID-19 response – our goal is to ensure that a range of representative voices are engaged in this forum.
- We welcome input to inform our ongoing response, and we will continue to engage with interested stakeholders moving forward.
