If we are looking for a large supplier to support over the next 3-6 months with continued stockpile requirements, Honeywell has the capacity to support.

They have the capacity to manufacture N95 masks out of their facility in Tijuana and other PPE products via Smithfield Rhode Island facility. They are willing to dedicate an entire line of their production to Govt of Canada, and can produce items in the 50M+ quantity.
