Unfortunately there is no mechanism for your constituent to be able to procure directly from the government.

Of note, we launched the federal Supply Hub to bring together available resources for organizations buying and selling personal protective equipment (PPE).

The Supply Hub will connect Canadian organizations from coast to coast to coast with federal, provincial, territorial and other resources and information about PPE, including consumer guidance. As Public Services and Canada (PSPC) continues to engage with our partners and advisory groups, the hub will evolve to include additional resources.

Thank you for reaching out.

On March 12, the Government of Canada issued a call to suppliers to find out what goods and services they could provide to support Canada's response to COVID-19. Over 26,000 submissions were received. As a result, the government was able to secure and distribute the PPE and medical supplies that were most immediately required. The call to suppliers is now closed. However, goods and services for COVID-19 requirements will be procured through tender opportunities posted on the buyandsell.gc.ca website.
