Tier 1 - COVID-19 - Procurement of personal protective equipment

CONTEXT (for your information):

The reporter is covering the COVID-19 pandemic, and reporting particularly on what Canada's Prime Minister announces daily. He's working on the next pandemic modelling by PHAC and the procurement of personal protective equipment.

QUESTION AND ANSWER:

Q1. The Prime Minister of Canada said this week that Canada will be getting millions more items of personal protective equipment. Does your department have a list of where all this will be coming from?

Our number one priority, right now, is getting the supplies needed, as quickly as possible, to protect public health. **As the COVID-19 situation is very fluid and evolving rapidly every day, so too are our the requirements and orders.**

We are exploring options for how we can report information related to these procurements—balancing our collective desire for transparency with the realities we are all facing at this time.
