Hi Cecely,

J.P. Tasker here from the CBC's parliamentary bureau. Hope you're well - and happy August.

I'm just reading through the documents that the department tabled with the Government Operations and Estimates committee - I'm specifically looking at the document entitled "Documents submitted by the Department of Public Works and Government Services - Part 1 of the motion."

I just wanted to confirm that this does indeed include all of the final contracts that were signed with PPE suppliers between Sunday, March 1, 2020 and Friday, May 15, 2020?

I've gone through it all and it seems to me that the first contract/order for N95 respirators was signed on March 18 (there are two separate contracts on that day - one for \$15.296.810 and another for \$7.684.000).

There are some contracts in this document package from February - there's one, for example, on February 14 for "medical equipment and supplies" - even though the committee didn't request contracts for pre-March 1.

Do you know if the government signed any contracts for N95 masks before March 1? I'm just trying to get a sense of when the first orders for these masks went in ...

I'm hoping to get something by tomorrow (Tuesday) midday. Let me know. Many thanks. -J.P. Tasker

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
