Dear Colleague:

I am pleased to note the following funding decisions and access to the statutory appropriation under the *Public Health Events of National Concern Payments Act*.

- Up to \$1.8 billion in 2020-21 to the Public Health Agency of Canada, to support the urgent purchase of personal protective equipment, ventilators and supplies needed to respond to COVID-19. Given the uncertainty of the situation in Canada and the expectation that there will be a need for future purchases, this includes a provision of \$500 million that will be made available upon the approval of the Minister of Finance.
- Up to \$7.5 million in 2020-21 to the Public Health Agency of Canada to support the Kids Help Phone and ensure counsellors are available to address the emotional and mental health needs of children and youth resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.

No Treasury Board approvals are required to implement these initiatives.

As this statutory appropriation is available until 30 September 2020, the department should advise the Secretariat of payments that may be required beyond the repeal date. Those amounts will be included in the next available Supplementary Estimates.
