Dear Miss Anand,

I am contacting you at the suggestions of Gary O'Neill from the Kerr Street Mission, where I am a volunteer. It is clear that the availability of PPE both for our front line medical teams, and going forward the civilian population who will need to return to work as we restart our economy is a significant concern for us all. I am in contact with a Canadian business man who has through his business established manufacturing capabilities in China that have now pivoted to produce Non-medical PPE in quantities of up to 700,000 units per day.

Currently their capabilities include the following:

Kn95 (non sterile); PM25 European standard w/carbon filter Washable and reusable; 3 ply civilian; 3 ply Juvenile size; 3 ply medical; Face shields

Additionally his supply chain provides access to Digital no touch Thermometers, bulk Hand Sanitizer and Empty bottles and caps all sizes.

They have agreed to provide proof of both capacity and quality as required to facilitate appropriate due diligence on your part should you wish to consider them as a potential supplier.

As a retired IT professional this is definitely not my sphere of expertise, however I feel it is everyone's duty to pitch in and help during times of crisis, so should you be interested in exploring this potential supplier, I will do all I can to help facilitate the process to ensure that the needs of Canadians are properly served.
