

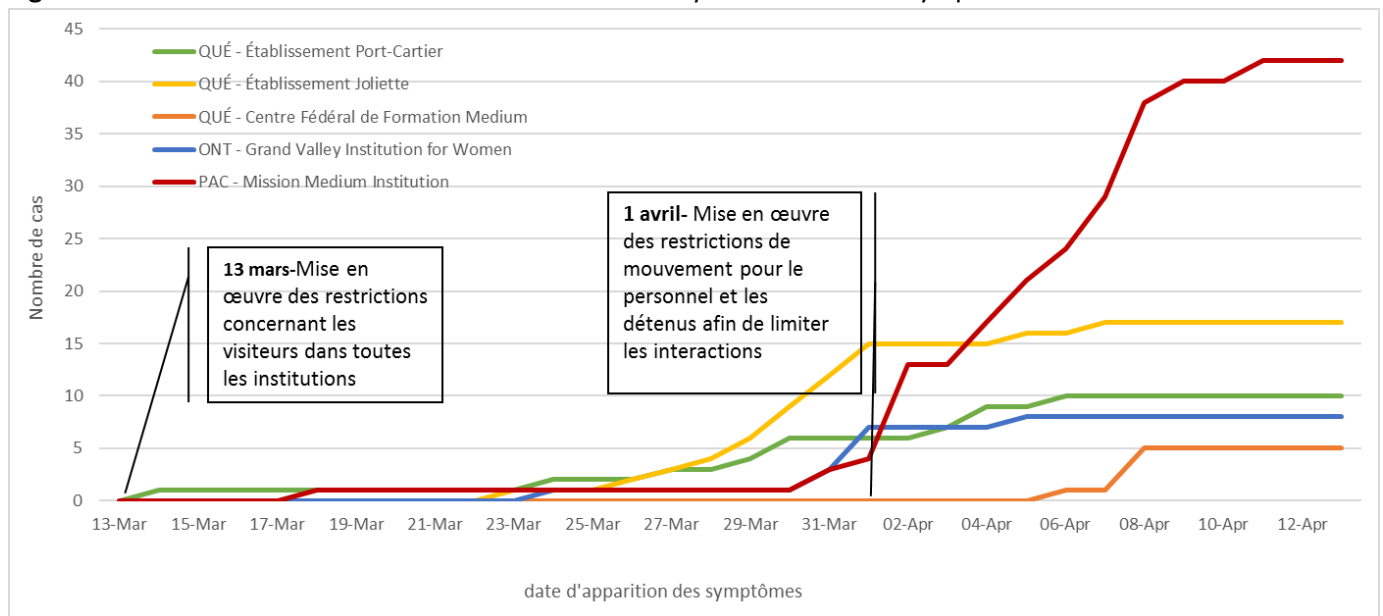
Epidemiological Summary: COVID-19 in CSC institutions, April 14, 2020

There are currently 82 laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 among inmates in five of the CSC's 43 institutions. The date range for the start of these cases is from March 14, 2020, to April 11, 2020. Table 1 below presents a supplementary descriptive analysis by institution.
