Dear Ms. Hajdu,

I hope you are well. I am a resident of the Ile de Montréal in the electoral district of Notre-Dame-de-Grâce. Its M.P., the Honourable Marc Garneau, has asked me to communicate with you directly (see attached email).

We would like to participate in the efforts of the Government of Canada to replenish its inventory of personal protective equipment to combat COVID-19. We are therefore proposing to manufacture protective gowns and surgical masks made entirely in accordance with the standards required by Quebec. We have attached a description of the manufacturing standards required for each of the items (attachments 1 and 2). Production capacity is in the millions for each product and the plants are located in Vietnam. We are perfectly familiar with the logistical chains for importing clothing into Canada from Vietnam since we have been working in this retail field for 15 years. Deliveries are ordinarily made by ship and we are currently exploring the use of planes.

We hope to build a strong partnership to support the collective effort to care for Canadians while ensuring that there is adequate equipment to protect healthcare workers. **If there are needs to be met, we would be pleased to take part in a discussion in order to offer you our services and clarify the quantities, timelines and prices.**
